



Announcement of Thailand Science Research and innovation (TSRI)
Regarding Policy of not accepting gifts from performing duties (No Gift Policy)
Fiscal year 2024

According to Organic Act on supplementing the constitution relating to the prevention and suppression of corruption, B.E.2561 (2018) section 128 and the Reform Policy for the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (revision), B.E.2563 (2020) Operation 4 Goal no.1 section 1.1, Thailand Science Research and Innovation (TSRI) is committed to perform allocation of budget for science, research, and innovation with honesty, transparency, fairness, and equal treatment. Hence, to prevent the conflict of interest between common good and individual gain, any bribery or gift which may affect public services, TSRI has established the Anti-Bribery policy and No gift policy as followed:

Section 1 TSRI would not accept any gift nor bribery that might relate to performing practice.

Section 2 TSRI executives and staff do not seek, give, or receive bribes, gifts, souvenirs, or others from performing performing duties.

Section 3 All TSRI personnel at all levels shall practice and have a duty to announce the policy to the public.

Therefore, this announcement has been made for your acknowledgement and to inform all TSRI personnel to adhere strictly to these guidelines going forward.
